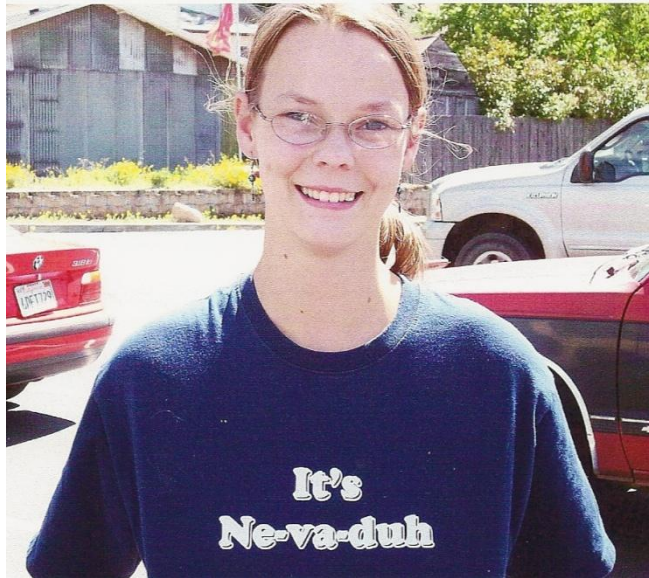


Benefit For Bailey

An 18 year old senior at Douglas High School is undergoing treatment at the M.D. Anderson Medical Research Treatment Center in Houston, Texas. She has been diagnosed with Osteosarcoma, the 6th leading cancer in children under 15. It affects 400 children under age 20, and 500 adults between the ages of 15-30 every year in the USA.

Approximately 1/3 of those afflicted will not survive this debilitating form of bone cancer.

She has been undergoing chemo therapy since last August, Bailey's father Wes, a Wal-Mart Distribution Center employee, was transferred there to be with his daughter; they are currently staying in the Ronald McDonald House in Houston, while the rest of the family continues on here in Gardnerville.

Chemo, Complications of treatment, Hurricanes, far from home and her friends, Baily is still attending classes online and is working diligently to earn her high school diploma from Douglas High School.
